# a) Update – Review of the City of Kingston Arts Fund

Mr. Wiginton introduced the report.

Councillor Amos asked for clarification on when the most recent review of the fund was conducted. He asked for the total amount the consultant for the review would cost and if it would affect the grants in the current budget cycle. Mr. Wiginton explained that while the fund is a smaller review conducted every year the Fund has not been comprehensively reviewed since its inception. He stated that staff were expecting to pay the consultant approximately \$75,000 to \$80,000 for the work. He confirmed that it

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would not impact the budget as the cost would be funding out of capital expenditures as a separate line item.

Councillor Osanic asked if staff and the consultant would meet with the H'art Centre. She asked further if the conversations would be in a one-on-one style. Mr. Wiginton stated that staff were making a significant effort to consult with everyone affected. He added that work would begin in the first quarter of 2024. Ms. Lochhead confirmed that one-on-one interviews would be conducted between the consultant and major groups like the H'art Centre.
